Planning to be a Catholic Teacher?

It is important for you to know that to be hired to teach in any Catholic School Board in Ontario, as part of your application for employment, there must be a letter of reference from your Pastor. **Please note that in order to be given a Pastoral Reference Letter, there must be evidence of the person living one's faith, must be registered for at least 12 months and genuinely trying to attend Mass every Sunday, as well as supporting the Church, it's charities and mission work.** If you, or if your adult child, are planning to apply to teach in a Catholic School, contacting the Pastor before Thanksgiving is **highly recommended.** Please plan to have a conversation with your Pastor early in the process and you will avoid disappointment and stress at a time when applications are to be submitted.
