MAY IS KNOWN AS THE MONTH OF MARY. This month is also dedicated to all earthly Mothers.

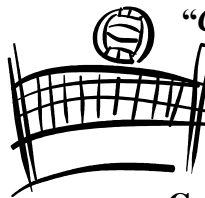
MARK YOUR CALENDAR

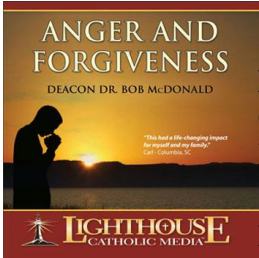
