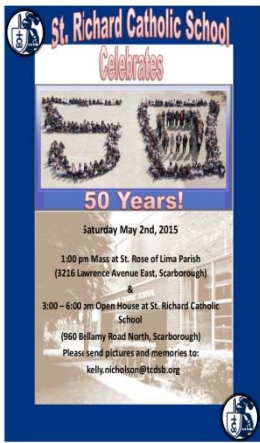

50th Anniversary**

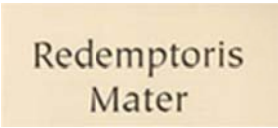

Parishioners will be able to go on line, download the order form, and send their request directly to the Vatican by fax or mail. The scroll order will be processed and sent directly to the parishioner, along with an invoice and shipping costs.
