- **TAI CHI** – Fridays from 7:30 p.m. – 9:00 p.m. in the Hall.

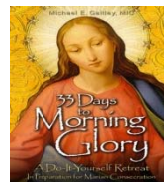

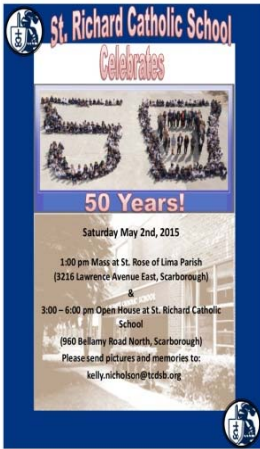
