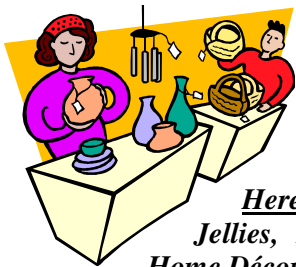
**OKTOBERFEST DINNER & DANCE**

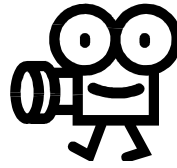
