R.C.I.A. INVITATION TO “INQUIRE”

“Inquiry” is a time to ask questions and seek information about the Catholic Church with the possibility of entering the process to become fully initiated into the Catholic Church. This time of inquiry is for adults who:

- Have never been baptized, or
- Who were baptized in another Christian Faith Tradition but are now interested in the Catholic Tradition, or
- An adult who was baptized Catholic but never learned about or practiced the Catholic faith, and perhaps never received the sacraments of Eucharist and/or Confirmation.
